Entry Requirements

- EU Citizen*
- At least sixteen years of age
- Candidates are required to obtain a Declaration of Fitness (from their local G.P.) to undertake this course
- Keen interest in seagoing and fishing career
- Leaving Certificate, or equivalent qualification and/or relevant life and work experience.
- Candidates selected by interview

* In accordance with present legislation, priority is given to applicants who are EEA National and those who have refugee status in Ireland. Non-EEA Nationals are welcome to apply. However they will be required to pay fees. Non-EEA Nationals will also be responsible for obtaining a visa and any other necessary documentation in advance of the course.

Qualifications

- A QQI National Vocational Certificate in Commercial Fishing is awarded to students who successfully complete at least eight (8) modules.
- A QQI Record of Achievement may be awarded to students who successfully complete individual modules.

Duration

A full-time Commercial Fishing Certificate course lasts 6 months which includes practical skills in the net loft and on the trawler deck. IT training in the classroom combined with hands-on experience onboard the MFV “Lough Swilly” is also carried out.

Further Information

Candidates are welcome to complete individual modules to enhance their employment opportunities.

Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport approved certificates in Personal Techniques and Elementary First Aid are awarded in addition to BIM’s Safety Training Card and GMDSS Radio Short Range Certificate Module 1.

Some modules are common to the QQI Certificate in Aquaculture to facilitate transfer between the fish farming and catching sectors.
