


Vessel Fishing for Demersal Species with Gillnets - Sheet 2








Vessels Pair trawling for Mackerel - *Sheet 2*




Vessel Targeting Blue Whiting and Making a Trans-shipment - *Sheet 1* At Sea To a Foreign Vessel


Vessel Targeting Blue Whiting and Making a Trans-shipment - *Sheet 2* At Sea To a Foreign Vessel




Vessel Potting for Crab in the Biologically Sensitive Area






Vessels Pair trawling for Albacore Tuna and Landing - Sheet 1 into France
