



Getting Started on the Water Stewardship Journey with Mapping

Getting started can be the hardest part. How Goatsbridge used Water Mapping to kick-start their water stewardship journey on site.

Goatsbridge Trout Farm is committed to using the best management practices they can to minimize the environmental impacts from fish farming. Therefore, the company was keen to get involved in BIM's Water Stewardship Support Programme to demonstrate this commitment. The first step Goatsbridge took on the programme was focused on building initial awareness and understanding

of shared water challenges and risks on site. This involved staff engagement and training to deliver the message in an engaging and interactive way. Goatsbridge went on to develop a Water Map which offered a powerful baseline for discussions with staff on the role each process plays in water consumption on site and the value of water to the business.
