Question

To ask the Minister for Agriculture; Food and the Marine to outline the internships, apprenticeships and graduate schemes run by his Department and public bodies under the aegis of his Department.

Response

BIM runs an Innovation Advisor Scheme, on average there are three participants that join the scheme each year and placements last between 11 and 24 months. Participants have qualifications in the areas of food science, marketing, and business and are based in BIM's Seafood Innovation Hub in Clonakilty, Co. Cork. The scheme is fully funded by the European Maritime, Fisheries and Aquaculture Fund.


